Mosque Services

Daily Prayers, Friday Khutbah, & Spiritual Guidance

The mosque serves as the spiritual heartbeat of our community, offering daily and weekly congregational services designed to keep hearts connected to the Divine.

Daily & Friday Prayers (Salah)

We facilitate the five daily prayers in congregation in a peaceful, uplifting environment. Weekly Jumu'ah prayers feature inspiring Khutbahs by qualified scholars, with multiple shifts to accommodate our growing community.

Ramadan Worship

During Ramadan, the mosque becomes a vibrant center of worship hosting daily Iftar gatherings and nightly Tarawih prayers led by expert Quran reciters.

Spiritual Guidance & Counseling

Our Imam and resident scholars provide family dispute resolution (Sulh), pre-marital counseling, and personal spiritual advice to support individuals and families.

Continuous Learning

Regular, brief Tafsir (exegesis) and Hadith circles follow daily prayers for ongoing spiritual nourishment.



Educational Programs

Quranic Studies & Classical Islamic Sciences

Our academic curriculum provides structured, rigorous pathways in both Quranic memorization and classical Islamic sciences, designed to produce knowledgeable and articulate ambassadors of the faith.

Hifz Program

A dedicated track for students to meticulously memorize the Holy Quran with proper Tajweed (rules of recitation), guided by certified instructors with traditional Ijazah (chains of transmission).

Alim / Alimah Course

A comprehensive multi-year curriculum covering essential Islamic sciences, including Fiqh (jurisprudence), Aqeedah (theology), Seerah (prophetic biography), and Usul al-Hadith (principles of prophetic traditions).

Traditional Transmission & Modern Pedagogy

Combining time-honored transmission with modern classroom methodologies. Regular assessments and academic counseling ensure each student reaches their highest potential.

Charitable Aid, Food Drives, and Support Programs



Driven by the profound Islamic mandates of Zakat (obligatory charity) and Sadaqah (voluntary charity), our social services department provides critical, life-sustaining support to vulnerable populations within and beyond our congregation.

- **Community Food Pantry:** Al-Suffah operates a community food pantry that distributes essential groceries to families facing food insecurity, regardless of their background or faith.
- **Zakat Management & Direct Aid:** We meticulously manage the collection and distribution of Zakat, ensuring funds are channeled directly to local families in severe financial distress, assisting with rent, utilities, and emergency medical expenses.
- **Refugee Resettlement:** We actively support refugee resettlement programs, providing newly arrived families with household goods, language translation assistance, and community integration support.
- **Healthcare & Wellness Initiatives:** Through strategic partnerships with local NGOs and Muslim healthcare professionals, we also host periodic free medical clinics, wellness checks, and mental health awareness workshops, fulfilling our duty to care for the holistic well-being of the community.

Main Musalla
